

COMMON METHODS OF ENTRY USED BY BURGLARS TO BREAK INTO YOUR HOME...

DOOR KICKS - a burglar can be in and out of your home in about 2 minutes.

WINDOW ENTRIES - a burglar can make a complete sweep of your home and personal property in about 4-5 minutes.

ARCADIA DOORS - a burglar can easily lift an arcadia door from its track or break it quickly with a swift hit from an object.

ATTACHED SHEDS - burglars have easy access to the attic. Once over the residence, they use a "ceiling kick" to gain entry.

OPEN GARAGES - burglars can make visual inventory of your valuables.
